To set the stage, art historian **PRISCILLA BAIN-SMITH**, author of "Van Gogh Walks...Paris!" will present a short overview of Michelangelo's works via slides and her usual engaging commentary.

# MICHELANGELO, THE POET, ASPECTS REVEALED

Michelangelo musings continue with **JAMES CHILDS**' reading of select sonnets and poems written by the Renaissance master. Childs, a classical painter and lifelong student of Michelangelo, includes the artist's telling self-reflective verse citing his life as a tool of "Art," the mistress he was born to serve." Platonic love (pervasive in Michelangelo's writings) is then explained as Childs relates select poems to visual images. These juxtapositions erase much of the mystery inherent in Michelangelo's poetry and place Michelangelo among the great poets of the Renaissance.
